Hello again. We hope this letter finds you and your loved ones healthy and happy. This past year has certainly been stressful and difficult to navigate, but our community continues to be resilient.

We are the James City Volunteer Rescue Squad, and we continue to provide multi-level EMS providers in a much-needed capacity. Our providers help maintain EMS coverage in the ever-expanding upper county and we continue to provide aid and services to Station 1, freeing up paid staff to serve in other capacities to fulfill needs throughout the community.

JCVRS continues in its mission to ensure coverage to our community and those who need our assistance in their moment of crisis, or for public service.

Station One continues to be the only station in James City County with the ability to put two ambulances into service at the same time. This can only be accomplished if JCVRS has the members who are uniformed and trained. Our volunteer providers are held to the same standards as county paid staff and must be able to perform at the same skill level.

We continue to provide monthly training, and we are proud to acknowledge one of our own volunteers has been hired by James City as the lead instructor for the county sponsored EMT class this year. This year we were able to purchase the necessary items to help teach this class as well as train both paid and volunteer members throughout the year. We have also added two additional EMT's to our organization.

This year your donation will allow us to continue to enhance and serve the emergency medical needs of our community as we continue to fulfill our role as frontline health care providers. And with the decline in Covid exposures and restrictions, our primary goal this year will be membership recruitment and training.
